Rockland Minerals Corp. is focused on developing its **Schefferville Gold property** and **Retty Lake copper-nickel, platinum-palladium (PGE) property** both located in the mining friendly province of Québec, Canada.

Schefferville Gold Property - Québec

Rockland is working to develop a new gold camp in NE Québec, near the town of Schefferville. Gold found in this area is in association with sulphides in silicate iron formations. These gold-bearing iron formations, unknown prior to 1985 and still inadequately explored, appear to be analogous with known gold-bearing iron formations of the Homestake (South Dakota 28 million oz), Jardine and Contwoyto Lake (Lupin) mines. Rockland's property covers known anomalies discovered by the Quebec government geologist and claims originally staked by the Iron Ore Company of Canada (IOC).

Phase 1 drilling has uncovered broad disseminated gold values. Highlights include:

Retty Lake Copper-Nickel-Platinum Group Metals Project- Québec

Retty Lake is an exceptional copper-nickel, platinum-palladium (PGE) exploration project located fifty kilometers northeast of Schefferville, QB.



Québec is ranked as one of the top jurisdictions in the world to explore and mine – Fraser Institute

The property has 4 known mineralized lenses adjacent to it and lots of potential to find new ones. The Cu-Ni-PGE mineralization is analogous to that of the Raglan/Ungava district of Quebec (Xstrata). A 1500 m drill program began in June 2011.

Both of Rockland's properties are optioned from the legendary Ernie Black, P.Geol, P.Eng.. In 2008, his original Peppler Lake and Lamalee Iron deposits (now owned by Consolidated Thompson) were classified as having a total indicated resource of 935 million tonnes at 29.72% total Fe.
